OUR VISION

NETES is an Indigenous non-profit community based program, providing education, training and employment services. NETES offers in-house and community-based projects (sub agreements). NETES has partnerships with industry, post-secondary institutions, philanthropic agencies and government. Its vision is that Indigenous people in Winnipeg have a future of increased economic prosperity and self-sufficiency.

EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

Employment Counsellors assist Indigenous clients to find employment and/or enter education and training through career exploration, employment readiness, job search and referrals to education and training.

EDUCATION AND TRAINING

NETES provides education and training through three programs. Neeginan Learning & Literacy Centre provides skill development in the areas of language arts, numeracy, science and social science. The Aboriginal Community Campus is an Adult Learning Centre that provides upgrading and the Mature Student High School Diploma.

Neeginan College of Applied Technology offers skills and technology training to the Indigenous community of Winnipeg; working closely with employers to prepare students to enter the workforce in high-demand industries. Each program provides culturally relevant programming, focusing on holistic personal development and community engagement.

Provides culturally appropriate care for the children of students attending NETES education and training programs. The infant centre accommodates 42 infants and the pre-school 80 children.



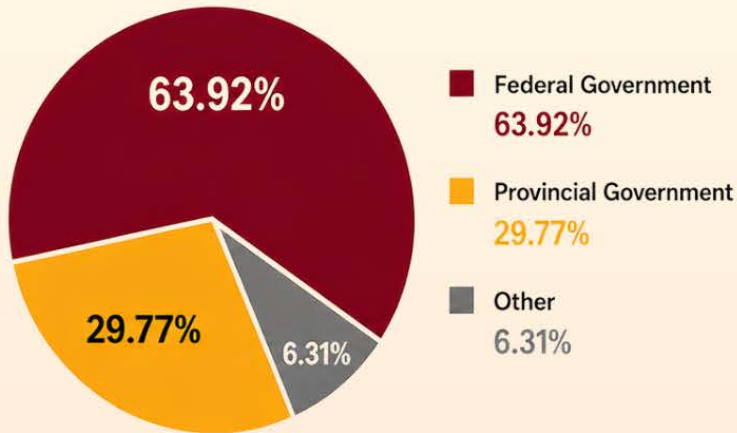
HEALTHY LIVING PROGRAM

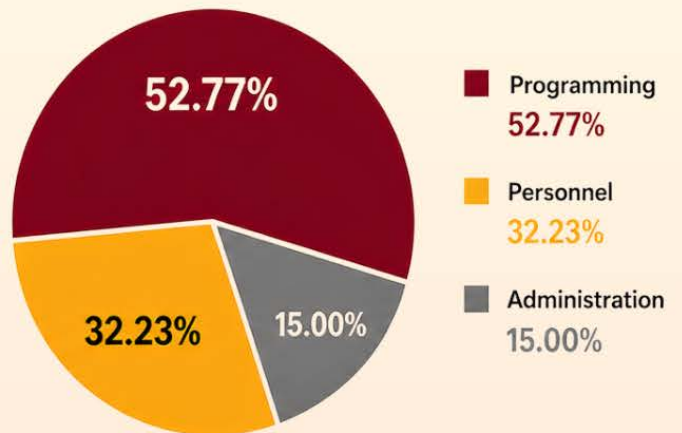


FINANCIAL SUMMARY
